Wireless Internet Access Policy

The Wayland Free Library provides free wireless access within the building. This access is <u>unsecured</u> with limited filtering for users with wireless enabled devices. Signal strength may vary within the building and offers no printing capability. Patrons may be asked to terminate an activity if it is determined that they are using too much bandwidth due to their computer activities.

By choosing to use this Wi-Fi connection you agree to abide by the Computer Use and Internet Safety Policy that prohibits abusive and illegal activity while using the library's internet service. This policy can be found in the Wayland Free Library Policies and Procedures Manual at the circulation desk.

The Library allows wireless access to any user with a wireless enabled device or there are four laptops available to use in the community room. First time users must obtain the system password to log into the network for the first time. The password will be changed periodically to protect the security of the network.

Persons using the library laptops are limited to one hour use unless no one is waiting to use the computer. Additional may be granted upon the discretion of library staff. Persons using the library computers may not use for commercial purposes.

Use of the library wireless network is at your own risk and cannot guarantee a connection. The Wayland Free Library is not responsible for any damage that may occur to your computer while connected. The library assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment, wireless device configuration, security, or data files resulting from connection to the library wireless access. Users must keep their equipment with them at all times.

At this time the library is able to provide limited technical assistance.

It is the responsibility of the user to understand this Acceptable Use Policy and his/her obligation to refrain from viewing inappropriate websites, spamming or any other illegal activities.

By using this wireless access network at the library, the user acknowledges that he/she is subject t, and agree to abide by all laws, and all rules and regulations of New York State, and the federal government that is applicable to internet use. These include but are not limited to:

The transmission of or receiving child pornography or harmful material is prohibited. Access to or display of obscene language and sexually explicit graphics as defined by New York State statutes is not permitted
